Sgt. Keirn - Metropolitan Police Department

- 600 block S shooting Bad guy shot a bad guy. Found with a gun. Good leads. Still open.
- Fall crime initiative More personnel. 2 distribution lockups nearby. Lot of overtime officers. Canine in the area.
- Be aware of surroundings.

- 10/19. Robbery 323 U St. 1:40 AM. 5 BM suspects approached. Fled scene. There were 5 arrests. All suspects had SE addresses.
- Shooting on 2nd St. & W. 3 students + 1 civilian. Stemmed from dispute on GA avenue.
- Streetlights or overgrown trees call 311. E.g. 500 block of T St.
- Serial masturbator near Farm at Park. Has happened 10 times this summer. Only 2 times has gotten a strong MPD response. Happens between 10 AM- 2 PM.
- Any plans for a surveillance post at park? Question for ANC/Councilmember. They are expensive. Just put one at 7th and S.

4th Street Traffic Calming Measures

Jack Gillum - Interested Neighbor

- Informal group of neighbors was concerned about safety on 4th street. Couple years ago, they organized to get DDOT to come out. End result is flex posts.
- Purpose of "bulbouts":
 - o Essentially narrows road so psychologically it slows them down.
 - o Has effect of extending curb for pedestrians.
 - Every time that DDOT puts these intersections in they see a reduction in collisions and speed.
- That being said, DDOT is open to changes. Not set in stone.
- In Bloomingdale, their civic association worked with DDOT to get planters and painted street art. DDOT wants to know neighbors are there to take care of planters. Willing to improve aesthetics if there's buy-in from LPCA.
- What is repaying order? Just a matter of administration? Once they repaye it they'll put them back.
